Here is a quick update on the Brooklyn, Ohio solar project. I was at the site last week to watch the installation of the last panels. As noted in past posts, this is the largest landfill solar project in Ohio. We were honored to serve as counsel to the developer (Enerlogics Solar). The builder is Conti Solar out of New Jersey, the owner is IGS Solar out of Columbus and the off-taker is Cuyahoga County.
